November 7-8, 2009 – President’s Council Meeting (PCM)

The Middle Tennessee Chapter recently submitted a nomination to host the 5th annual ISACA President’s Council Meeting (PCM) for the Central U.S. and Canadian chapters. Competing against the chapter were nominations from three other regional chapters. Based on a vote of all chapters in the region, Middle Tennessee won the opportunity to host the event. Details are still being finalized, but the event will be held November 7-8, 2009 at the Gaylord Opryland Resort. The event will start on Friday night with many participants flying in to stay at the resort. Chapter members may organize a dinner to welcome those arriving Friday night. The PCM officially starts on Saturday morning and includes presentations organized by ISACA International. Following Saturday’s sessions, the chapter has organized a dinner and entertainment on the General Jackson Showboat. Sunday will again have more presentations, with the PCM concluding around lunch time. ISACA International will be providing content for all sessions and fees for all events are paid by the chapters attending the event (i.e., the Middle Tennessee chapter is not having to fund the event). The number of attendees is still TBD at this point, but we’re estimating approximately 30 total attendees
